

Technology

1. Our Jive phone system has been revised and should be more user friendly.
2. Chromebooks have been distributed to grade 2 -8. Additional Chromebooks for the first grade have been order and should be in soon.
3. Home directories for Administration and Staff has been put in place on our server for backup with no additional cost to the district.
4. Our virus protection is now in place on our server and is pushed down to our laptops and desktops.
5. The items obtained from Region 7 has been inventoried and usable resources have been put into place.
 - a. 5 Servers of which none are usable
 - b. 10 printers of which 4 are usable and are in place
 - c. 47 laptops of which 19 are usable and either are in place or are ready for use.
 - d. 12 desktops of which 5 are usable and ready for use.
 - e. 5 switches of which 2 are usable and will be put in place when needed.
 - f. 2 storage carts that are usable and 1 in place now and 1 will be used for first grade Chromebooks.
